

The Bronte Economic Development Corporation 4B held a public hearing on Monday, June 24, 2013, at 4:30 p.m. in the Bronte City Hall at 114 S. Washington, Bronte, Texas. The purpose of the public hearing was to receive public comments concerning the Corporation use of Economic Development funds for the purchase of real estate. President Gerald Sandusky presided over the meeting.


Board members present included President Sandusky, Lee Wommack, Martha Ratliff, and Martin Lee. David Bedford, Paul Knight and Alan Richey were absent. Tammy Thorn and Clerk Fran Sonnenberg were also present. No visitors were present.


The Bronte Economic Development Corporation 4B held a special meeting following the public hearing. President Gerald Sandusky presided over the meeting.

The ordered sale of seized and levied property of Tract 3: R 000005171 Block Sixty-two (62), all of Lots Nine, Ten, Eleven, Twelve, and Thirteen (9, 10, 11, 12, and 13), Original Town of Bronte was discussed. This property has been set for sale by Coke County on the first Tuesday of July, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. at the Coke County Courthouse. Martin Lee moved that if the opening bid was \$14,464, the Corporation representative would be authorized to raise the bid \$500.00 for up to three bids if necessary. If there is no opening bid, the representative should bid \$8000.00 for the property described. Lee Wommack seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Martha Ratliff moved that the Corporation President and Vice-President (or someone appointed by these two officers) be granted authorization to act on behalf of the board concerning expenditures of any budgeted items. Lee Wommack seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
