

The Bronte Economic Development Corporation 4B held a special meeting on Wednesday, November 18, 2015, at 5:00 p.m. in the Bronte City Hall Council Room at 114 S. Washington, Bronte, Texas. President Gerald Sandusky presided over the meeting.


Board members present included President Sandusky, Martin Lee, Martha Ratliff and Lee Wommack. Quinda Duncan and Paul Knight were absent. Clerk Fran Sonnenberg and Crystal Blevins were also present.

Jodie Arrott, representative of Bronte Restoration Foundation, presented information to the board concerning several of the foundation's proposed projects. These include the following:

1. Resurfacing the basketball and tennis courts at the park.
2. Playground equipment. This would be funded through grant money and money raised through special events.
3. Walking trail. This would be a two mile safe walking trail. Wesley Nurse Bonnita Bale is presently working on a grant for this project.
4. Redo the volleyball court. The foundation plans to do this project with their own volunteer help with some assistance from the county.
5. Frisbee golf course.

At the present time, they are requesting financial support from the EDC for the first project – resurfacing the basketball and tennis courts and replacing the fencing. They are applying for \$40,000 grant from San Angelo Area Foundation, which has a January deadline, for the resurfacing. They need to have \$20,000 matching funds for this grant. They have a bid for \$17,055 for this fencing project. Martin Lee moved that the EDC approve the fencing project for the Foundation to proceed with this proposal and obtain Coke County Commission Court's approval along with an interlocal agreement between the City of Bronte and Coke County that matches the agreement presently held by the City of Robert Lee and Coke County. Lee Wommack seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
